Job Title	Physical Education

The Teacher of Physical Education will be expected to:

- Teach PE to all age groups (Nursery – Year 10) where required.
- Work with the Heads of PE and the Director of Sport to secure the strategic vision of the school and department.
- Deliver the highest possible educational standards and create a high expectation culture in which students feel safe, valued and motivated to succeed.
- Ensure high standards of achievement and progress alongside set targets within PE, as identified through assessment data and testing.
- Provide high quality PE teaching, effective use of resources and high standards of learning and achievement for all students.
- Aspire to create enrichment opportunities for students to study additional aspects of the subject beyond the core curriculum, in line with PE, Sport and CCA programmes.
- Fully commit to the CCA and Sports programme and attend after-school and sometimes weekend matches and tournaments.
- Support and sometimes be expected to lead the running and hosting of sports events at the school (tournaments, galas, sports days).
- Regularly use data to monitor, evaluate and report on the progress and attainment of designated groups and individuals across all year groups in PE and put in place appropriate interventions to improve their achievement.
- Help to manage standards of learning and behaviour in the PE department and wider school on a day-to-day basis, ensuring high expectations and full commitment to achieving outstanding outcomes.
- Ensure all equipment is managed and maintained in lessons and CCAs and stored correctly in a safe and appropriate way.
- Be committed to professional development in the subject area, attending courses and CPD events relevant to the requirements of the department and school.
- Be professional at all times, creating a supportive and cohesive environment within department and the wider school community.
- Take on any further reasonable responsibilities within department in line with the Head of PE and Director of Sport.
