Marlborough College Malaysia

There is something genuinely special about Marlborough College Malaysia. Those fortunate enough to work here all agree that our greatest joy, attribute, advert and reward are the pupils who form the College. They provide daily inspiration, a model of what wider society could be like and genuine optimism for the future.

We live and work in a safe and spacious 90-acre campus in southern Malaysia, reminiscent of the generous grounds and playing fields of Marlborough College in the UK enhanced by our own organic farm and boating lake. Guided by our principles of compassion, companionship and conversation, Marlborough College Malaysia gives its pupils the space, inspiration and courage to explore their own potential, the wonders of our world and their responsibilities to it and to each other.

The College is arranged as a Prep School (3-13) and a Senior School (14-18) and currently has 970 pupils, around 570 in the Prep and 160 in the Sixth Form. Pupils from the age of nine may choose to board and approximately a third of those who are eligible, do so, with almost half of the Senior School and most of the Sixth Form boarding. The Singapore Tatler has referred to the College as “the only school in Asia offering an authentic British boarding programme”.

The College is very well-resourced and enjoys an enviable reputation for its pupils’ achievements on a broad variety of fronts. It is one of the few schools in Asia to achieve membership of HMC, an association of the world’s leading independent schools, to have the Council of British International Schools’ coveted “Beacon” status and to have won international plaudits for innovation and excellence from the UK’s Boarding Schools’ Association. It was listed in The School’s Index (by Carfax Education) as one of the world’s 150 leading independent schools in 2024, for the fourth consecutive year, and one of the top 10 schools in South East Asia. It appears in the Spear’s Index of top 100 private schools in the world, and was awarded ‘International School of the Year’ by the Tes. Following a recent ISI inspection MCM has also achieved the prestigious BSO (British Schools Overseas) status.

Marlborough College Malaysia enjoys very close links with Marlborough College in the UK and remains one of the few (possibly the only) international school which is a wholly owned subsidiary of its founding educational institution and entirely not-for-profit. Unlike most international schools where profits are required to repay investors, instead all Marlborough College Malaysia surplus is committed to Marlborough’s charitable aim of providing the finest quality education and the school thrives as an example of the best that a British independent school education has to offer.

The Role

Reporting to: Head of Biology or Chemistry

The Master is seeking a well-qualified and enthusiastic Teacher of Biology and Chemistry to join our established teaching team at Marlborough College Malaysia's Senior School. The successful candidate will join an exceptional group of Senior School teachers whose pedagogy, commitment and care for our pupils is exemplary. Flexibility is important for all of our teachers and the successful applicant is likely to teach some combination of Science in Years 7 and 8, Biology and Chemistry to IGCSE and either Biology or Chemistry to IB level.

The post-holder will be expected to play a full part in the boarding life of the College and this will include a weekly boarding duty and some weekend duties. The weekly timetable may include coaching Games and a contribution to the rich co-curricular life of MCM that is essential to our vibrant school. Our ethos is underpinned by maintaining good communication and building strong relationships within and across the College and our families.





Key Responsibilities

- To teach across Key Stages three to five (Year 7 - Year 13), according to the timetable for the current year, ensuring that lessons are planned, ordered and effective
- To be aware of the need to differentiate work and challenges according to the ability of the pupils, whilst maintaining high expectations of all and taking full account of any linguistic or other special needs
- To work as part of a team, in harmony with and for the furtherance of the College's ethos and declared educational aims and priorities
- To be supportive of the department's aims, agreed teaching styles, methods of assessment and other policies
- To set written assignments or other creative pieces of work that involve a finished product (prep) regularly and mark them promptly and in accordance with College and Departmental policies, ensuring that formative comments are always helpful and make helpful suggestions for further appropriate improvement in learning
- To provide parents with written reports on their children's work and progress according to current College policy and to attend parent-beak meetings
- To take a share of boarding duties, invigilation and cover for absent colleagues
- To be responsible for the supervision, control and proper use of teaching rooms, materials and resources, and to have regard to health and safety issues and regulations
- To attend Common Room meetings, Master's briefings and other meetings that may be called from time to time, as required by the Head of Senior School or Master
- To report in a timely manner any concerns regarding Child Protection or bullying to the appropriate colleague
- To take responsibility for one's continuing professional development and, to this end, to participate in Development and Review procedures as directed by the Head of Senior School
- To contribute to the College's broad and active co-curricular activities programme

The duties set out in this document are not intended to be exhaustive, and teachers may be required to carry out such other duties as the Master may reasonably require from time to time.

Essential Skills and Abilities

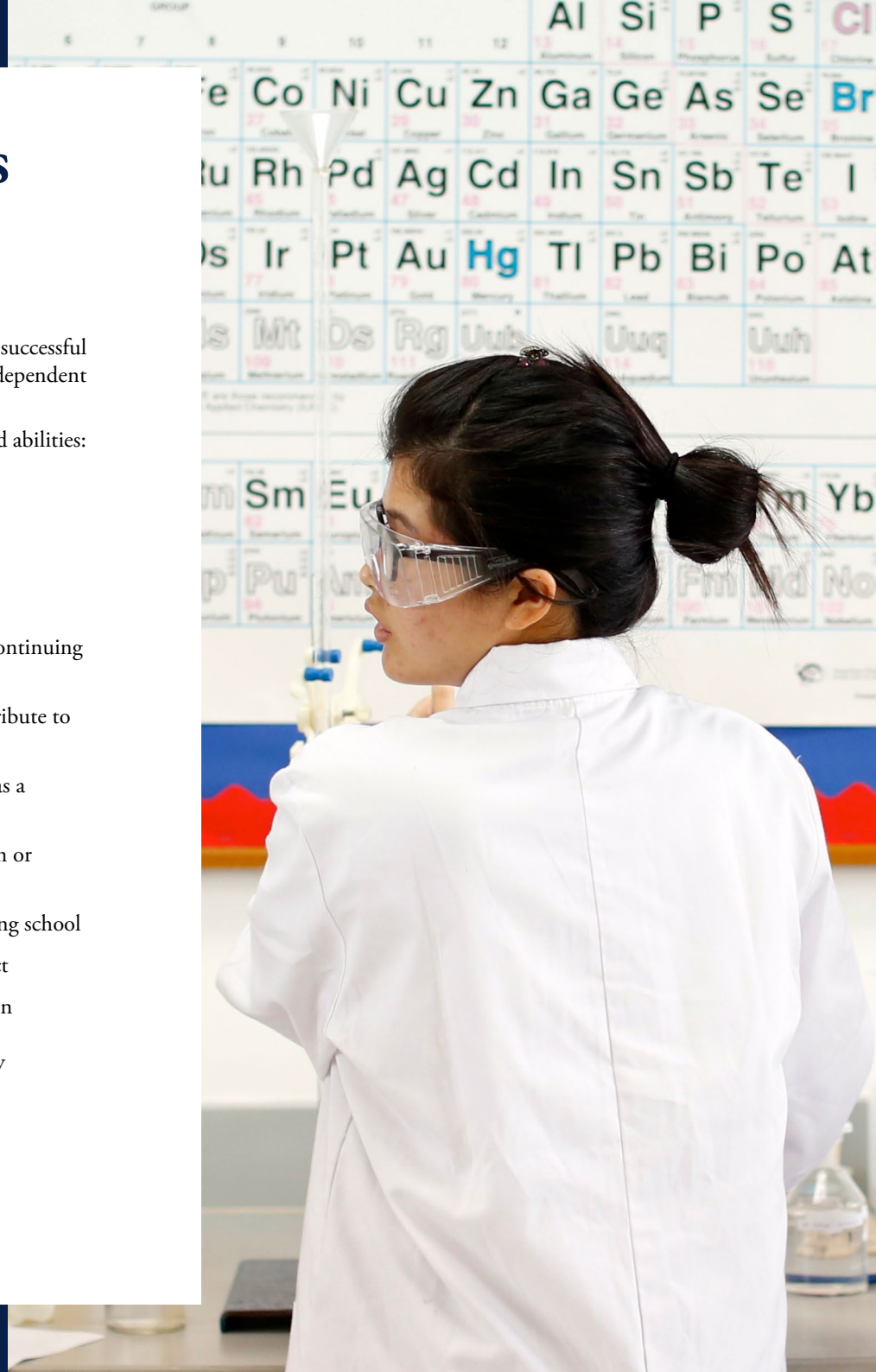

- An accredited teaching qualification
- Ability to teach either Biology or Chemistry to KS5
- Evidence of either being or having the potential to be an excellent teacher
- The ability to inspire and motivate children
- Clear and effective in English communication skills
- Willingness to make a significant contribution to the co-curricular life of the School
- An ability to relate well to colleagues and children
- Willingness to contribute to boarding duties or activities along with all other academic staff
- Approachability, accessibility and flexibility
- High levels of organisation
- Sympathy with the values and the nature of working in a boarding environment

- A higher degree or experience of educational or subject-specific research
- A record of and commitment to continuing professional development
- An ability and willingness to contribute to the coaching of the college's sport
- Experience of pastoral work such as a House or Year tutor
- Experience of external examination or school inspection
- Experience of working in a boarding school
- An ability to teach a second subject
- The ability to develop and maintain effective relationships with all members of the school community





Terms and Conditions

Marlborough College Malaysia offers a competitive salary and benefits package.
