EF Academy Oxford is in search of an A Level and IB Diploma Mathematics teacher to join our faculty in the upcoming academic year. The chosen candidate will be tasked with delivering captivating lessons that inspire and motivate our students. This full-time role, reporting to the Head of Mathematics, commences at the end of August 2024.

Situated in an international boarding school environment for students aged 16-19, we maintain small class sizes to ensure individual attention. We hold our students to very high academic standards and are seeking a teacher who can not only meet these expectations but also instil a passion for their subject specialisation. This role is suitable for an ECT.

Key responsibilities will include:

- **Plan and deliver high-quality lessons:** Develop and deliver A Level and IB Diploma Mathematics lessons in line with the A Level and IB Diploma Subject Guides, ensuring alignment with EF Academy Oxford's Academic policy.
- **Provide formative feedback:** Ensure all students receive high-quality formative feedback, reflecting this in marking practices.
- **Implement intervention plans:** Design and implement subject-specific intervention plans to support underachieving students.
- **Produce informative subject reports:** Create comprehensive subject reports that highlight students' strengths, weaknesses, and strategies for improvement.
- **Stay updated on educational advancements:** Continuously stay informed about the latest developments in Mathematics and Computer Science education.
- **Promote academic enrichment:** Encourage and facilitate academic enrichment activities for students both within and beyond the classroom.

EF Academy Oxford requires all teachers to take on the role of Academic Tutor, offering guidance and support to a designated group of students. Teachers are also responsible for running an after-school club or activity and conducting extra support sessions for students seeking clarification. Periodic participation in evening and weekend excursions, along with involvement in student life activities, is deemed essential, contributing to a well-rounded educational experience for our students.
