Job Description

We are seeking an enthusiastic PE Teacher to join our PE department for September 2025/January 2026.

As a PE Teacher you will be required to:

- To teach all forms Games and P.E. The key sports are Football, Rugby, Cricket, Athletics, Cross Country and Swimming
- Assist with the planning and preparation of long, medium and short-term plans for P.E., Games and Swimming, appropriate to the needs, interests, experience and existing knowledge of the pupils in each form
- To assess pupils' work and to record their development, progress and attainment.
- To referee/umpire matches against other schools and internal House fixtures
- To assist in planning and running the annual Sports Day and Swimming Gala
- To maintain good order, sportsmanship, discipline and respect for others among pupils; to promote understanding of the school's rules and values; to safeguard health and safety; and to develop relationships with and between pupils conducive to optimum learning
- To build and maintain co-operative relationships with parents, and communicate with them on pupils' learning and progress
- To provide oral and written assessments, reports and references for individuals and groups of pupils

- To take part in the life of the school by attending assemblies, House meetings and Parents' Evenings
- To contribute fully to the extracurricular life of the school including running after school clubs
- To be a role model and inspire children with an enthusiasm and love of sport
- To teach other subjects if required as directed by the Headmistress

Salary
