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

Shrewsbury School in the UK

Founded by Royal Charter in 1552 under King Edward VI, Shrewsbury School is one of the 'great' nine schools in England identified by the Clarendon Commission of 1861. Over the last 472 years it has grown in size and reputation and is now ranked amongst the leading co-educational boarding schools in the world, educating pupils aged 13-18 years.

On a breath-taking 110-acre site on the banks of the River Severn, pupils participate in a wide range of sporting, music and co-curricular activities, as well as being encouraged to engage in adventure and charitable endeavour. The academic provision at Shrewsbury School is tailored to the needs and enthusiasms of the individual and engages pupils in a learning process that combines inspirational teaching with a commitment to encouraging intellectual curiosity. Shrewsbury School aims to ensure that all its pupils leave as fully rounded, well-educated, and responsible adults, committed to contributing to their communities.

With Charles Darwin and Sir Philip Sidney among the numerous illustrious former people and icons for generations of Salopians, the school has a rich tradition which continues to guide the pupils studying at the school.

The establishment of Shrewsbury International School Phnom Penh as the fourth member of the Shrewsbury global family signified an exciting expansion of the brand's presence beyond the United Kingdom. We also have the prestigious distinction of being the first British premium brand school to open in Cambodia and the only school with a 'great nine' sister-school status. Shrewsbury India becomes the fifth member family in 2025.



Chroy Changvar Campus

Our purpose-built school campus at Chroy Changvar provides a family atmosphere and many specialist teaching facilities in the residential, riverside neighborhood in the Chroy Changvar.

The early years and primary school have small class sizes and low student to staff ratios, ensuring the attention is given to each child and that they feel safe, known and supported.

In addition to dedicated classrooms for each class, the campus also has an impressive range of specialist teaching facilities for a primary school, including:

- dance studio
- drama studio
- music studio and practice rooms
- design and technology classroom
- specialist art room
- science laboratory
- computer science suite
- swimming pool

These facilities provides fantastic opportunities for developing subject specialism and love of learning.

The green space at the Morgan EnMaison site and the spectacular riverside location provide extra attractions on our doorstep that provide easy and safe access to open areas.

a 7 hectare, world-class campus

Our extensive campus boasts over 7 hectares of modern, purpose-built educational facilities, that have been specifically designed to deliver our bespoke curriculum and support the Shrewsbury ethos of Floreat learning. It is an amazing stage for 'whole person' education and upon which students will flourish.

Our campus hosts:

- an impressive Performing Arts Centre which houses superb teaching spaces for drama, dance and music as well as performance spaces featuring a 200 seat 'black box' theatre and a world-class 600 seat professional grade theatre;
- a richly resourced STEAM subject teaching and learning areas (computer science suites, design & technology workshops, art studios and science laboratories);
- extensive indoor and outdoor sporting facilities including indoor sports courts and an outdoor full size soccer pitch and 400 m athletics track;
- an Aquatics Centre (with a 50 * 25 m Olympic and indoor learner swimming pool), landscaped play areas and a 'forest school' learning space for primary and early years;
- a lecture hall, auditorium, library and modern classrooms throughout;
- support facilities including a medical centre, counselling areas and well-being spaces;
- a Primary School with many specialist teaching and learning spaces, normally only found in secondary schools.

EARLY YEARS - AN EXCEPTIONAL BEGINNING

We are dedicated to providing an exceptional early education for children between two and five years old. We tailor all teaching to the needs and interests of each individual, enabling your child to truly flourish within a carefully created and inspiring learning environment.

Our Early Years setting provides the essential first steps to enable your child to thrive throughout their life. We believe in play-based learning. The learning environment, combined with the work of our expert, caring staff, will foster your child's confidence and bolster their well-being from the outset of their learning journey. The children in our setting are enabled to explore, enquire, problem-solve, create and innovate as they learn through play. Our specialist Early Years staff facilitate our inspired, independent young learners to use their natural curiosity to make excellent progress across the Early Years curriculum.

Your child is therefore at the very heart of all we do here. We fully recognise that your child will develop uniquely. The work we do in our Early Years will enable your child to truly flourish and will set them on the path to becoming a successful, lifelong learner.



PRIMARY - THE BEST OF BRITISH

In line with the approach in Early Years, for our primary years education for children aged five to eleven years old, our emphasis is on making learning challenging, stimulating and engaging for all. We look to instil a love of learning in all our students and enable them to make the very best progress for their individual ability.

The children are encouraged to approach lessons with enquiring minds and develop key skills that will help them meet future challenges and become independent lifelong learners.

Students thrive in our broad primary curriculum, centred on core literacy and numeracy skills that underpin all other subjects. Reading is promoted and supported throughout the school with designated libraries and a focus on 'Reading for Pleasure'. The curriculum aims to inspire and challenge students and allow them to experience as wide a range of subjects as possible over the course of their time in primary years. Students benefit from being taught by subject specialists in areas of the curriculum, increasingly so in Key Stage 2.



SECONDARY - DEVELOPING EXCEPTIONAL PEOPLE

At the secondary level (eleven to eighteen years old), students are exposed to a wide range of subjects and disciplines, including performing arts subjects such as dance and drama, modern foreign languages and then have opportunities to narrow their choices at Key Stage 4 and then again at Key Stage 5 to further develop subject specialism. Typically, students will study up to fourteen such subjects at Key Stage 3, ten subjects at Key Stage 4 (IGCSEs) and four subjects at Key Stage 5 ('A' Level).

Up until Year 11 all students will also have regular lessons in PSHE (Personal, Social, Health and Economic Education) which gives children opportunities to develop more confidence across a range of issues related to growing up, maturing and dealing with health and relationships.

At A-Levels choices are widened to include new subjects, especially in the humanities and social sciences (eg. Economics, Philosophy, Global Politics) but also link to earlier pathways to provide continuity and progression.



OUTSTANDING TEACHERS

We understand that our parents in Cambodia want their children to be taught by highly qualified, passionate and caring teachers. Therefore, we only recruit the very best teachers who are able to deliver the UK curriculum and do so in a manner which is faithful to Shrewsbury School's educational philosophy.

Many of our teachers are educated, trained and qualified in the UK and have experience in British schools, both at home and abroad. We also have a number of specialist teachers who we recruit from around the world to deliver high-quality teaching and learning in areas such as languages (Mandarin and Khmer).

Our teachers are able to interpret the curriculum and find an approach that best suits the learning needs of the children in their classes.

Co-curricular programme : Finding passions

The co-curricular programme is fully supported by passionate and skilled staff who deliver the programme, by excellent facilities and by the opportunities that come from being part of a wider regional network of British international schools, and part of the Shrewsbury family of schools.

Students when they are younger will be encouraged to 'try themselves out' and 'take risks' by taking part in activities that are new to them. As the students grow older the emphasis shifts to developing excellence, leadership and commitment to fewer co-curricular endeavours. Students are also guided to ensure they participate in a range of activities that give opportunities to develop interest and talent in sport, the creative arts and service. In essence, co-curricular involvement is fundamental to the Floreat model of whole-person education.

A holistic education is not left to chance; we structure the school experience to ensure all children take risks and try new things and can demonstrate commitment and develop excellence.

Pastoral Care : Outstanding support



All students feel that they are known, valued and belong. Each student will be allocated a Tutor, a teacher who spends time every day with their Tutor group. The Tutor, and the House to which they belong, form the basis of the pastoral system at Shrewsbury International School Phnom Penh. By supporting children to find their own solutions to problems, all children will be encouraged to develop maturity, confidence and independence.

Houses form the core of pastoral care at Shrewsbury International School Phnom Penh. As at Shrewsbury School (UK), the House system encourages a sense of identity, belonging and teamwork. House competitions provide excellent opportunities for life lessons to be learnt as students learn to win and lose together. Houses provide a 'family' for students within the larger identity of the school and children have the opportunity to shape the traditions, character and history of their own House.




The Salopian Club: A Rich Legacy
