

LIVING IN BRUNEI

The official language of Brunei is Bahasa Melayu (Malay), but English is widely spoken, making communication easy for expats.

Brunei is a tax-free haven, with a lower cost of living than many other high-income countries. Everyday expenses, such as petrol, utilities and leisure activities, are affordable, giving expats greater flexibility to enjoy their time in Brunei and take advantage of regular travel during the generous school holidays.
