Dear Potential Applicant

RE: Vice Principal; Curriculum & Quality

I am delighted you are interested in the post of Vice Principal, which arises from the decision to extend the Senior Leadership Team and appoint a practising RC to the post of Vice Principal who has ambitions to become a Principal within the next 2 years.

Ann Clynch our present Principal is retiring in August 2018. Peter McGhee will be Executive Principal from August of both Loreto Sixth Form College and St John Rigby College. During his eight years at St John Rigby College, Peter has led continuous improvement resulting in an Ofsted judgement of 'outstanding' in every category in February 2017. In addition, in December 2017, he was appointed as one of seven National Leaders of Further Education and is the only sixth form college Principal to have been appointed to this role. Earlier in his career, Peter spent twelve years working at Loreto College in roles, which included Head of Mathematics and Senior Tutor. Therefore, he is entirely familiar with and supportive of the Loreto values. We are delighted Peter has agreed to lead Loreto College, initially from 1st August 2018 to 31st March 2020, and to work with the new Vice Principal and the Senior Leadership Team to establish more permanent arrangements for the leadership of Loreto College.

Loreto Sixth Form College is located in Hulme, a mile south of the centre of Manchester and very close to Manchester University and Manchester Metropolitan University. It is a part of an international network of Catholic schools and colleges established by the Loreto Sisters. It works under the Loreto English Trust Board. All the Loreto schools and colleges in England are part of and participate fully in the work of the Loreto English Educational Network. Loreto College was designated by the National College for Teaching and Leadership as a Teaching School in March 2014. It works in partnership with four other schools as "Teach Manchester" to support schools to improve performance.

Loreto College thrives on the challenge and privilege of supporting students to develop their gifts and exceed their potential. Whilst we are pleased with our high ranking in league tables, we know this is the fruit of an aspirational culture and ethos which inspires all to work hard and achieve more than they thought possible.

Our students and staff benefit from the confidence success brings which in turn encourages them to persevere on their journey of continual improvement. We strive to recognise and nurture the gifts of each member of our community. We want our students to become servant leaders, to use their talents for the greater good and in the words of Mary Ward our foundress, to "become seekers of truth and doers of justice."

I am confident if you visit the college you will love it. The ethos is palpable, coming from inspiring students and exceptional staff that are formed in a community, which takes its inspiration from gospel values through the prism of the teachings and example of the Venerable Mary Ward.
