The Principal

Adrian Frost MA (oxon)

Adrian Frost was promoted to Principal in July 2019 having previously held the role as Vice-Principal and Founding Head of Secondary. Previously, he was Deputy Head Master and Vice Principal of Brighton College, Abu Dhabi, and in the UK, held leadership positions at some of the world's leading academically distinguished schools, including St Paul's Girls School, London, Magdalen College School, Oxford and Brighton College, UK.

Nursery and Reception


In the Foundation Stage, we nurture and support each and every one of our youngest learners, helping them to explore, investigate, discover and create. Our teachers are passionate, committed and caring, and provide outstanding educational opportunities and experiences. Everything we do is about learning. We believe that learning has no limits and our aim is to make learning irresistible to young children.

The curriculum aims to enable every child to flourish in all areas of their learning and development and is delivered through a multi-sensory, play based approach. Our Early Years programme is based on the UK's Early Years Foundation Stage Framework, while also reflecting the culture and heritage of Abu Dhabi and the UAE. The framework gives a clear picture of the way in which we help our Nursery and Reception children to learn, including how we assess each child's progress.

The classrooms are bright, modern, and well-resourced with Smartboard technology and access to iPads. The school has its own Foundation Stage music room, gym and library, all located within the department. All classrooms open onto outdoor areas so our young learners have easy access to engaging and enabling indoor and outdoor environments. These also act as an extension of the classroom, allowing children to access a wide range of learning opportunities throughout the day.

All children in Nursery and Reception learn to swim in a weekly swimming lesson taught by our experienced PE specialists. This is a wonderful opportunity to develop early confidence in the water and to ensure our children acquire the necessary competence in this important life skill.





Primary - Key Stages 1&2

Our UK-trained professionals teach in well-resourced classrooms where curiosity, confidence and independent learning are cultivated. Using the National Curriculum of England as a framework, a broad and rich learning experience is delivered through a dynamic, thematic curriculum with an international flavour.

The Primary school at Amity, comprises Years 1 to 6. We aim to support children's development into well-rounded learners who are fully equipped with the flexibility, resilience and resourcefulness to embrace whatever lies ahead. Our curriculum is designed to capture the fun, inquisitiveness and creativity that we believe should lie at the very core of teaching and learning. At the heart of all we do, through our curriculum and co-curriculum, is a focus on developing the skills necessary for learning: resilience, problem-solving, critical thinking, communication, teamwork, organization and independence. We aim to ignite children's imagination while simultaneously equipping them with the skills they will need in the Secondary School and beyond.

We teach the value of perseverance and life-long independent learning; we inspire confidence so our children take charge of their own learning. At Amity, the process of learning is celebrated rather than the outcome. Our students are not afraid to make mistakes but instead use them as the catalyst for learning.

In addition to providing a comprehensive curriculum, we encourage our students to also join extra-curricular activities to explore drama, art, music, team sports, sailing or others from the many on offer, to ensure they transition from the Primary to the Secondary School confident and adventurous in their learning.

In the upper primary year groups, we combine the best of primary practice with highly specialist teaching in Music, Languages, Art, Computing and PE. These teachers, all experts in their fields and passionate about learning.



Secondary - Key Stages 3&4

At Amity, we prepare students for careers that have yet to be invented. For roles that require adaptability, creativity and the confidence to pursue initiative together, with a willingness to embrace change and innovation. Our education provision fosters a passion for learning and allows students to gain the skills and character attributes that will enable them to be successful in their personal and professional lives.

'Inspiring Excellence' is a core aim of the school's mission. By means of a broad curriculum encompassing the Arts, STEM subjects, Humanities and Languages, students experience a rich curriculum prior to focusing their academic studies at GCSE and A Level. We ensure students develop skills and traits that go beyond the National Curriculum: collaborative and leadership skills, self-governance, resilience and creativity are as necessary for future success as academic excellence. Our co-curricular programme and pastoral structure, together with our academic curriculum, ensure that our students grow into balanced, independent global citizens. Core to each student's school experience is their 'House'. Each student belongs to one of our four Houses and is allocated a tutor who helps each student set ambitious targets in both the curriculum and the co-curriculum.

At the end of Year 11, students sit a range of GCSEs and IGCSEs from the very broad range of subjects on offer. In certain circumstances, we maintain flexibility within the curriculum structure in order to accommodate earlier (I)GCSE entry, depending on the abilities and progress of each particular student. Considerable attention is given to the development of research, analysis, reflection, essay writing and presentation skills within the curriculum. Together with the Amity Diploma and co-curriculum, the full education we provide prepares all students for post-16 study whether that be A-levels, the International Baccalaureate or more vocational courses.


In order to ensure that each student receives a tailored education, we conduct a rigorous benchmarking of their prior learning, abilities and interests at the start of their Secondary school journey. Progress towards agreed targets are reviewed through regular one-to-one meetings with tutors. All facets of their school experience are reviewed in these meetings to ensure all aspects of their growth are taken into account.

The School Site

Amity was founded with a clear aim to offer pupils with an educational provision that would be second-to-none within Abu Dhabi. In order to achieve this, the school was founded within a stone's throw of an inlet of the Arabian gulf on a 5 acre campus that not only provided stunning views of the blue waters and mangroves but the city beyond.
