We are seeking a dynamic and experienced individual to teach Computer Science within the Diploma Programme (DP) as well as STEM afternoon clubs (e.g. coding, Robotics) The ideal candidate will be passionate about empowering students and teachers to thrive in a technology-driven world.

The ideal candidate will have 7+ years of teaching experience, and a deep commitment to fostering academic excellence.

Key Responsibilities:

- Design and deliver training programs that equip teachers with the necessary digital skills to effectively integrate technology into their teaching practices. Provide ongoing support and mentorship to the teachers in the use of technology in classrooms and school operations.
- Evaluate and recommend digital tools, platforms, and resources that will enhance teaching and learning outcomes.
- Work closely with academic leaders, IT team, and external vendors to ensure the successful implementation of digital initiatives.
- Ensuring that students learn about safety online and become responsible Digital Citizens. Membership of the Safeguarding and Child protection Committee with a remit to keep students safe online.
- Develop the curriculum and teach Computer Science and ICT/Design in the IB MYP and DP, delivering engaging, inquiry-based lessons that align with the IB philosophy.

- Inspire students to develop their technical skills and critical thinking through the exploration of programming, systems design, cybersecurity, and emerging technologies.
- Design and administer assessments that measure students' progress and provide constructive feedback to help them achieve academic excellence.
- Collaborate with other subject teachers to create interdisciplinary projects that integrate technology and support students' overall learning experience.
- Lead or support technology-focused extracurricular activities, such as coding clubs, robotics, or tech competitions.

- A Bachelor's degree in Computer Science, Design, Technology Education, or a related field (required by the Cyprus Ministry of Education).
- A relevant Master's degree and teacher qualification is an advantage.
- Relevant teaching experience 7+ years within the subject area(s), preferably in an IB school (MYP and/or DP) will be highly appreciated.
- A proven track record of outstanding student outcomes and academic success.
- Expertise in curriculum development, assessment, proven ability to plan and deliver innovative inquiry-based lessons that engage students.
- A strong commitment to creating a dynamic and inclusive classroom environment that encourages curiosity and collaboration and addresses diverse learning needs.
- The ability to integrate real-world problem-solving and interdisciplinary approaches into lessons, making learning engaging and impactful.
- Familiarity with the IB framework and its principles of inquiry-based, student-centered learning is an advantage.
- Excellent interpersonal skills to mentor students and collaborate effectively with colleagues.
- Fluent English Language (C1-C2).
