We merged with another local primary school in September 2022 and are proud to have opened a 2 year old provision, extensive Family and adult learning with a children's centre and community hub development later this year. Rhyl is a unique school in Camden and leads the way as a school serving the community with extensive wrap around services. It is a very exciting time to join our school as we continue to expand and develop.

We have a high number of children with wide ranging and complex Special Educational Needs and are strongly committed to inclusion for everyone. Rhyl is recognised as providing excellent inclusive provision for children with complex needs and this is due to our highly skilled and committed staff. We want our pupils to have the highest aspirations and the highest achievement possible. Our children are well-motivated, enthusiastic and eager to learn. We have developed an exciting cross-curricular and creative curriculum which provides meaningful learning experiences for all of our children.



We have an award-winning kitchen garden and teaching kitchen and work closely with the Jamie Oliver Food Foundation to promote growing and cooking within the curriculum as well as with Adopt a Chef and the Ritz who have adopted the school and run workshops with the children.
