- Monitoring the quality of learning within Drama, promoting the development of new approaches and the raising of academic standards
- Establishing policies for assessment appropriate to target setting, supporting future learning and reporting to parents

- Encouraging reflection among staff in Drama and further professional development by means of Performance Management
- Providing expertise and training to staff, including ITT and NQT
