JOB TITLE: Class Teacher

RESPONSIBLE TO: The Headteacher

General Duties:

The education and welfare of a designated class of pupils in accordance with the requirements of the Conditions of Employment of Teachers, (School Teacher's Pay and Conditions Document), having due regard to the requirements of the National Curriculum, the school's aims, objectives and schemes of work, and any policies of the Governing Body. To share in the corporate responsibility for the wellbeing and discipline of all pupils.

Responsible for the education and welfare of children.

Line Management:

Headteacher

Key Tasks:

- a) To have responsibility for the education and welfare of pupils in the Primary phase of education.
- b) To deliver and plan good/outstanding lessons in line with National Curriculum requirements.
- c) To ensure that all pupils make good progress.
- d) To identify the needs of individuals and groups and to ensure their specific needs are being met.
- e) To model good/outstanding teaching and assessment for learning.
- f) To provide clear feedback, good support and sound advice to other teachers and associate staff.
- g) To work with parents to promote home-school collaborative approaches.
- h) To work collaboratively with outside agencies, including health and social services, to support the educational progress of our pupils.
- i) To work collaboratively with an assigned mentor or performance manager
- j) To attend relevant professional development programmes and to attend school-based INSET days.

k) To be pro-active in safeguarding and promoting the welfare of children, keeping up to date with all policies and procedures in this area.
