- To be an ESL specialist with a proven track record and training in supporting children with English as a Second Language To facilitate learning by establishing a relationship with pupils and creating an effective and stimulating learning environment
- To work as part of a team, reviewing and developing the curriculum and producing resources and schemes of work to support learning for the full ability range
- To be able to teach across the full primary age range
- To enhance the quality of teaching and learning in the School through sharing resources and good practice, lesson observations, collaborative teaching, mentoring and active participation in continuing professional development
- To contribute to our boarding provision through weekly duties and a contribution to the broader life of the school
- To be a native English speaker or have a C2 level of proficiency in English
