Job Description

The School

Hulme Hall Grammar School is an independent school for boys and girls, based in Stockport. It was established in 1928 and has approximately 180 pupils on roll, from Pre-School to aged 16. The School prides itself on providing a caring, supportive environment where every pupil is treated as an individual. Small class sizes in combination with excellent teaching, lead to consistently good examination results.

The Governors are seeking to appoint a committed and enthusiastic Teacher of French and possibly Spanish on a part-time basis. This post suitable for either an ECT or experienced teacher.

The successful candidate will:

- be QTS qualified by the start date
- be able to teach French at Key Stage 3 and Key Stage 4
- be able to teach Spanish at least to Key Stage 3
- prepare, evaluate and develop appropriate schemes of work for all pupils within the department
- be able to plan and prepare lessons according to departmental and whole school policies
- be able to motivate and inspire students
- be able to promote and ensure high standards of discipline among pupils, both inside and outside of the classroom
- have a belief in the ability of all students to achieve and succeed
- be committed to safeguarding and promoting the welfare of children
- share and support the school's ethos and vision and commit to delivering the highest standards of achievement and personal growth and development for students.

Line of Responsibility:

The Teacher is responsible to the Head of Faculty, the Assistant Head (Curriculum) and, ultimately, the Headmaster.

Operational Responsibilities:

1. To work within the Modern Foreign Languages Department throughout the school, setting high expectations and to be proactive in raising standards in this subject.
2. To monitor and report on attainment and progress of pupils in French and Spanish across the school.
3. To monitor the development of French across the School and to report findings to the Head of Faculty / Assistant Headteacher.
4. To sustain positive relationships with all pupils / staff and relevant external stakeholders.
5. To develop and take part in co-curricular MFL opportunities for the children.
