Our sixth-form bridges the gap between school and university, by carefully guiding each student on their own individual pathway to their future. As an authorised official Pearson Exam Center, our 70-80 students, ranging in age from 16-18 years old, take the British Curriculum A Levels. In addition to the five and a half weekly hours of lessons in small classes, students benefit from individual weekly fifteen-minute meetings with each of their subject teachers.
