- 10. An appreciation and understanding of the demands of scholarship and other entrance requirements and procedures to the senior school SPS feeds.

- 11. To show proactivity and confidence when communicating with parents.
- 10. To oversee any specific responsibilities that fall under the department's brief (trips theatre / field / educational, reading days, public speaking, laboratory / library etc).

Performance Expectations:

- 1. That the department is properly staffed.
- 2. That the department has a comprehensive and up-to-date scheme of work.
- 3. That members of the department are encouraged to attend professional development courses as arranged.
- 4. That the department meets on a regular basis and that minutes are kept.
- 5. That an annual budget is established and the spending thereof monitored.
- 6. That teaching is good, work is marked according to the School marking policy and that children's work is of the requisite standard and well-presented, according to the school policy for the presentation of work.
- 7. That Head of Department appraisal is undertaken when requested.
- 8. That teachers are kept informed of current developments in the subject.
- 9. That examinations are monitored.
- 10. That the wider responsibilities of the position are properly discharged.
