Design and Technology is a popular subject at Hall Park Academy consisting of 2 full time teachers and 1 part time teacher, assisted by a full time departmental technician. The department has three well-equipped classrooms and workshops, a dedicated Food Technology room and an ICT enabled Engineering room.

The faculty, which also includes two part-time teachers of art, has successfully adapted to curriculum changes in all Key Stages and strives to continue to develop in response to the ever changing world of technology and is actively involved in STEM activities.

Design and Technology is taught to all pupils in Key Stage 3. Students can choose to pursue the subject at GCSE and A Level through AQA Design Technology or BTEC Engineering Level 2 in Key Stage 4 and Level 3 at Post-16. We also offer Food Technology at Key Stage 3 and as a GCSE at Key Stage 4.

The Design and Technology Faculty works closely with other schools in the Redhill Trust within a strong network of support and expertise. Future developments include continued modernisation of the curriculum and teaching resources with an emphasis on engagement and challenge.
