The persons appointed will be expected to have an understanding of current national educational developments concerning the teaching of Modern Languages in secondary schools; and to have experience of teaching Spanish and French in relation to the requirements of the National Curriculum.

There are currently six members of staff in the Languages Department and teaching mostly takes place in rooms which are grouped together. Rooms have an interactive whiteboard and the department has a full range of audio-visual equipment. All departments in the school have secretarial help and reprographic technician support. In addition, there is an ICT network throughout the school.

As part of this team you will be responsible for the delivery of outstanding and engaging lessons across all year groups. You must possess the skills and determination to make a significant difference to the lives of our students. As a team, we ensure that every one of our students maximises their potential through outstanding learning, teaching and support.

Modern Languages teaching is a strong feature of the work of the school. Current Year 7 pupils are taught French and Spanish and choose their preferred language to continue studying at the end of Year 7. At KS4, up to 65% continue with a MFL GCSE course. Students currently follow the EdExcel GCSE courses in French or Spanish.
