

## **Job Description: School Counsellor**

It is the expectation of the school that each employee will offer his/her services wherever and whenever necessary to ensure the success of our organisation.

This post holder will work closely with the heads of school and pastoral team to provide interventions and promote positive mental health schoolwide.

## Responsibilities:

- To provide culturally relevant, one to one interventions and group support for students across Primary and Year 7.
- To liaise with relevant staff members to ensure a wrap-around service for students in need of support.
- To attend and contribute to meetings and case conferences for students on your caseload.
- To comply with the Child Protection and Safeguarding procedures including undertaking risk assessments for young people and engage in CP Review meetings.
- Deliver presentations and facilitate training and workshops to staff members and parents on current issues affecting young people.
- To keep accurate, confidential case notes.
- To be a visible support to students in the learning environment.
- To develop preventative interventions in response to the needs of the students.
- Any other reasonable duties as required
