This position will be to support Aboriginal and Islander students from Transition to Year 6 and the focus will be in the three main areas:

- Home and Community Liaison and Engagement
- Input into teacher and school resources
- Student Support

Key Responsibility:

The role of the AIEW is to support the education, engagement and retention of Indigenous students by; liaising with and actively engaging parents/carers and the wider family and community to build support and understanding of the education processes, building capacity and knowledge of school staff in Indigenous culture and culturally safe pedagogy as well as contributing to the development of culturally appropriate programs, including the delivery of a cultural education program to staff at the school.

Education Requirements:

- High level of Literacy and Numeracy skills
- Working towards a relevant education qualification / or the desire to start

Essential Criteria:

- Commitment to contribute to the mission and Catholic ethos of the School
- Current Ochre Card (or ability to obtain one)
- Strong Indigenous Cultural knowledge
- Demonstrated understanding of the education processes and policies
- Demonstrated ability to build positive working relationships with students, staff, families and the wider community
- Demonstrated strong work ethic and the ability to maintain confidentiality
- Current driver's license

This is an identified position in accordance with the Northern Territory Anti-Discrimination Act.
