The Cedars is a rapidly expanding independent boys' school with a growing reputation for sport.

The school's three core sports are rugby, football and cricket, and regular fixtures are played against prestigious opposition such as Dulwich, St Benedict's, Trinity, Wallington, Whitgift, Wilson's and Worth. Although still a relatively small school, we are punching well above our weight and have performed well in local and national competitions.

The school has a large playing field at the rear of the site on which rugby/football pitches and cricket squares have been laid. Four new cricket nets were installed earlier this year and The Cedars has set up the UK's first Real Madrid Social Sports School in partnership with the Spanish club.

We are seeking an enthusiastic and motivated Teacher of Physical Education with a strong background in cricket and the ability to coach rugby. Candidates should have experience of teaching students between the ages of 11 to 18 and the position may suit an NQT. A full driving licence would be an advantage and the ability to teach Sports Science to GCSE is essential.

The Cedars is situated in an attractive parkland setting within the Metropolitan Green Belt. Lloyd Park tram stop is close by and there is a frequent tram service from there to East Croydon Station (6 minutes) which is well connected to Clapham Junction (9 minutes), London Victoria (17 minutes), London Bridge (14 minutes) and St Pancras (25 minutes).
