Year 7-11 students follow a 5 year scheme of work with 4 lessons per week. Students also have access to PiXL Maths app, SAM learning and Hegarty Maths which are online tools we promote to enhance the learning of our students. Year 12 and 13 follow the Edexcel specification for A level Maths and Further Maths, students currently study Mechanics and Decision in Further Maths.

You will be given all the freedom you need to be creative and you will be working with students who have chosen to be at a successful school.
