Job Description

Overview

Mathematics is a key subject at the International College, taken by all students and currently taught by the Lead Teacher of Mathematics, as well as one other Teacher of Mathematics. In Year 9, all students are taught a GCSE preparation course. In Year 10, students start the iGCSE course. In Year 11, all students are set into classes that either cover just the iGCSE, or the iGCSE and a Level 2 Further Mathematics qualification. The department is vibrant and students regularly participate in competitions. This post is open to qualified teachers of all levels of experience, including NQTs. The successful candidate will enjoy working in a supportive setting, with small class sizes (maximum 12) and working with an experienced Lead Teacher. The Teacher of Mathematics will report to the College Principals.

Teaching and learning

The Teacher will be responsible for ensuring that the students enjoy and achieve highly in their learning. This will involve ensuring that Mathematics conforms to the College standards both in delivery and outcome. This involves:

- creating stimulating lessons appropriate for the different levels of student
- providing opportunities for students to discuss and question in class
- providing informative feedback to students, both written and verbally
- making use of technology appropriately and effectively
- developing and providing opportunities for mathematical growth outside of lessons
- working closely with the Lead Teacher of Mathematics
- working closely with the SENCO and Lead Teacher of EAL
- ensuring that all required assessments and reporting are completed on time

Professional and personal qualities

The successful applicant will be an excellent and empathetic communicator, both inside and outside of the classroom. S/he should combine a high level of professionalism with energy, enthusiasm and good humour. S/he will exhibit patience, flexibility and tolerance, and possess very good administrative skills.
