Background

ISB is non-selective, and currently has over 1100 students from over 40 different nationalities. Academic results are outstanding with IB Diploma results consistently above the World Average. ISB students attend their first choice universities all over the world

In addition to the Bandar campus, ISB Seria, 1 hour from the capital, is the second campus which caters for primary students. ISB is also in the process of establishing a Centre for Inclusive Learning to support further students with learning needs. An English Language Centre (ELC) and a CACHE Adult learning programme completes the ISB offer.
