

Primary Class Teacher

Our primary school will deliver a bilingual programme of the highest quality, based on the content of the Italian primary curriculum but delivered increasingly in English as the children's proficiency develops and supplemented by British and other international elements. Our primary teachers will plan, design and deliver lessons to classes of children from Italy and many other countries. They must be able to communicate effectively with parents from a range of different countries and cultures, many of whom will regard our school as a central part of their new life in Sardinia.

The ideal candidate will have:

- A recognised teaching qualification in primary education, preferably a *Scienza della formazione primaria*, and the right to work in Italy
- Experience of teaching primary aged children in a school environment
- Experience and knowledge of the Italian primary curriculum

In addition, all teachers at Sardinia International School are expected to:

- Participate appropriately in parent meetings and other events in the School's calendar
- Follow the School's guidance for the assessment of pupils, including opportunities for feedback and reporting
- Ensure that there is purposeful and structured planning for courses, lessons and activities
