- To work as part of a departmental team, reviewing and developing the curriculum and producing resources and schemes of work to support learning for the full ability range
- To assist the Head of Science in meeting the requirements of the (I)GCSE and IBDP syllabuses and to ensure all students are thoroughly prepared for public examinations
- To teach across the full age range from grade 6 to grade 12 (IB2)
- To enhance the quality of teaching and learning in the Department and wider School through sharing resources and good practice, lesson observations, collaborative teaching, mentoring and active participation in continuing professional development
- To contribute to our boarding provision through weekly duties and a contribution to the broader life of the school
