Purpose of the job:

The Academy:

Main Responsibilities

Teaching and Learning Responsibilities require teachers to comply with the following factors:

1. Focus on the teaching and learning of music

- Teach music lessons in all year groups
- Ensure lessons are engaging, motivating and of the highest standard
- Assess pupil progress in musical knowledge, skills and attitudes

2. Lead on the development of the music curriculum across the school

- Work with colleagues to create a knowledge and skills music progression document
- Review and improve the music curriculum when required
- Ensure aspects of the music curriculum links to class learning journeys

3. Embed the school's curriculum principles

Ensure the music curriculum embraces the school's curriculum principles of: enquiry based learning, equality of opportunity, awe and wonder and sustainability





4. Exercise professional skill and judgement

- Demonstrate great teaching across the primary range
- Willingness to share best practice with colleagues
- Maintain personal expertise and attend relevant training
- Uphold the school's vision, values and ethos

5. Engage in extra-curricular activities

- Arrange a variety of music opportunities ensuring a high level of participation by a wide range of students
- Liaise and work with other music professional to enhance the school's music offer
- Deliver some of the extra-curricular music opportunities
- Organise and attend out of school musical opportunities for children within the school

6. Collaborate on School Performances

- Work with colleagues to support with any musical input required for school performances
- Take responsibility for conducting and directing ensembles where appropriate
