

Job Description: Maths Lead Practitioner

The Role

The post of Lead Practitioner has the responsibility for modelling, leading and embedding the development of outstanding teaching and learning practices in Maths and numeracy at Havant Academy. For the right candidate additional responsibilities regarding the mentoring of ECTs across the whole school may be available (additional TLR).

The Lead Practitioner will be:

- A role model and champion of learning with excellent subject knowledge
- Clear thinking and outward looking
- Dynamic, innovative and hardworking

Overall objectives of the post will be to improve the quality of teaching and learning in Maths, inspiring others to develop all aspects of their pedagogy. The postholder will also support the implementation of the school's Teaching and Learning strategy.

Key Responsibilities

Within the Maths faculty

- Maintain expert knowledge of teaching and learning and disseminate this to other teachers
- To raise standards of student attainment and achievement within Maths and to help to raise the aspirations of students
- Help to develop student enjoyment of Maths as a subject and achievement at all key stages
- Assisting in the development and implementation of the curriculum.
- Contribute to the monitoring of standards of teaching and learning

Teaching and Learning

- Work closely with the Teaching and Learning team to develop and implement school's Teaching and Learning strategy within Maths
- Quality assure Maths teacher feedback in line with the School Assessment and Feedback Policy
- Observe colleagues' teaching (through subject monitoring) and provide evaluative feedback on the effectiveness of their teaching strategies to bring about further improvement

Monitoring & Tracking

- Support teachers in planning appropriate strategies to achieve student progress target levels and objectives

CPD

- Maintain 'leading edge' knowledge through reading, INSET and research to inform his/her own practice, demonstrating impact in teaching and on students' learning.
- Working with the T&L team, assimilate and implement new curriculum guidance to



support the process of change across the Maths department.

- Where necessary, be available to mentor and coach staff to develop confidence and maintain positive attitudes

General Responsibilities

- To promote the School's values and ethos in accordance with the School's Code of Conduct
- To work actively to create and promote an engaging learning environment for all students at Havant Academy
- Carry out other specific duties as directed by the Headteacher
- Directed time as and when advised by the Headteacher

This job description may be amended at any time following discussion between the Headteacher and the member of staff, and will be reviewed annually.
