Critical Responsibilities

- Under the reasonable direction of the Principal, carry out the professional duties of a school teacher as set out in the current School Teachers' Pay and Conditions Document (STPCD).
- To raise standards of student attainment and achievement within Maths and to monitor and support student progress.
- To be accountable for student progress and development within Maths.
- To develop and enhance the teaching practice of others.

- To ensure the provision of an appropriately broad, balanced, relevant and differentiated curriculum for students studying Maths in accordance with the aims of the Academy and curricular policies.
- To be accountable for leading, managing and developing Maths.
- To be responsible for the implementation of whole Academy awards in Maths.
- To lead and develop the quality of learning for students within Maths.
- Ensuring teachers are abreast of latest research and national developments relating to Maths.
- Ensuring schemes of work and teacher delivery contribute to the curriculum.
- Monitoring the quality of teaching and learning through regular classroom observations.
- Working with the Principal / Vice Principal / Assistant Principal to identify areas of student and staff need for development and planning intervention.
- Ensure quality of teaching and learning is good or better by identifying and sharing best practice and implementing coaching and intervention strategies.
- Ensure all students engage and make progress by leading planning and pedagogy for differentiation and follow through within the classroom groupings and best use of Learning Coaches.
- Procurement and effective use of resources for learning and links to latest technologies for learning.
- Manage the development and use of Learning Coaches to promote best practice and effective progress for all students.
