Key Areas Responsibilities

2. Classroom Management To maintain classroom discipline and help maintain school discipline in accordance

with school policy standards and procedures; to arrive promptly at lessons and dismiss learners at the correct times; to keep checks on learners' attendance and follow up absences as appropriate; to liaise with Curriculum Leaders and/or pastoral

staff on matters of concern relating to individual learners.

**3. Recording Learner**Progress
To keep appropriate records of individual learners' work and achievements, consistent with departmental and school policy; to make a proper contribution to the

writing of school reports; to complete such National Curriculum assessments as are

required.

**4. Pastoral Responsibilities** To teach the pastoral curriculum and to follow conscientiously personal, social and

health education syllabuses and schemes of work; to act as coach and guide to individual learners in your class, both in relation to personal development and specific

phases of educational development and transition.

**5. Administration** To carry out efficiently the various necessary administrative functions of the class

teacher including school requirements in relation to the proper and accurate keeping

of registers.
