

Job Description: Curriculum Leader - Motor Engineering

Role Specific

- 1. Lead the Motor Engineering curriculum team and work alongside the Head of Division to ensure the division's teaching, learning and assessment are of outstanding quality
- 2. Take responsibility for achieving the section's targets in retention, attendance, achievements, high grades, added value and student satisfaction
- 3. Support the Head of Division in the management of resources
- 4. Lead the curriculum teams in responding effectively to curriculum developments
- 5. Ensure professional development activities are appropriately planned for the team and the individuals within the team
- 6. Conduct staff reviews and learning walk activities
- 7. Hold regular curriculum team meetings and ensure effective communication across College
- 8. Be up to date, plan and prepare high quality teaching, as required by your Line Manager, to the appropriate number of hours (120 hrs per annum remission)
- 9. Develop and share resources for the course/subject including maintaining effective links across College for resources
- 10. Maintain comprehensive, up to date, student/course/subject records and provide information, as requested
- 11. Be responsible for the appropriate administration of exam entries for the course/subject and liaise with external awarding bodies, as appropriate
- 12. Liaise directly with external awarding bodies, as appropriate, regarding Quality Visits, exams and CPD
- 13. Ensure close liaison and good communications with other staff in matters concerning students
- 14. Use College systems to track and communicate student progress in a timely manner
- 15. Act as a Personal Tutor, if required
- 16. Value and support students to achieve their full potential
- 17. Effectively manage the behaviour of students
- 18. Engage in curriculum development and planning activities, individually and as a team
- 19. Participate in standardisation/verification and moderation, as required
- 20. Ensure provision is aligned with internal and external partners to ensure best practice Take responsibility as required for the development of a relevant curriculum area
- 21. Positively represent the College both internally and externally at all times
