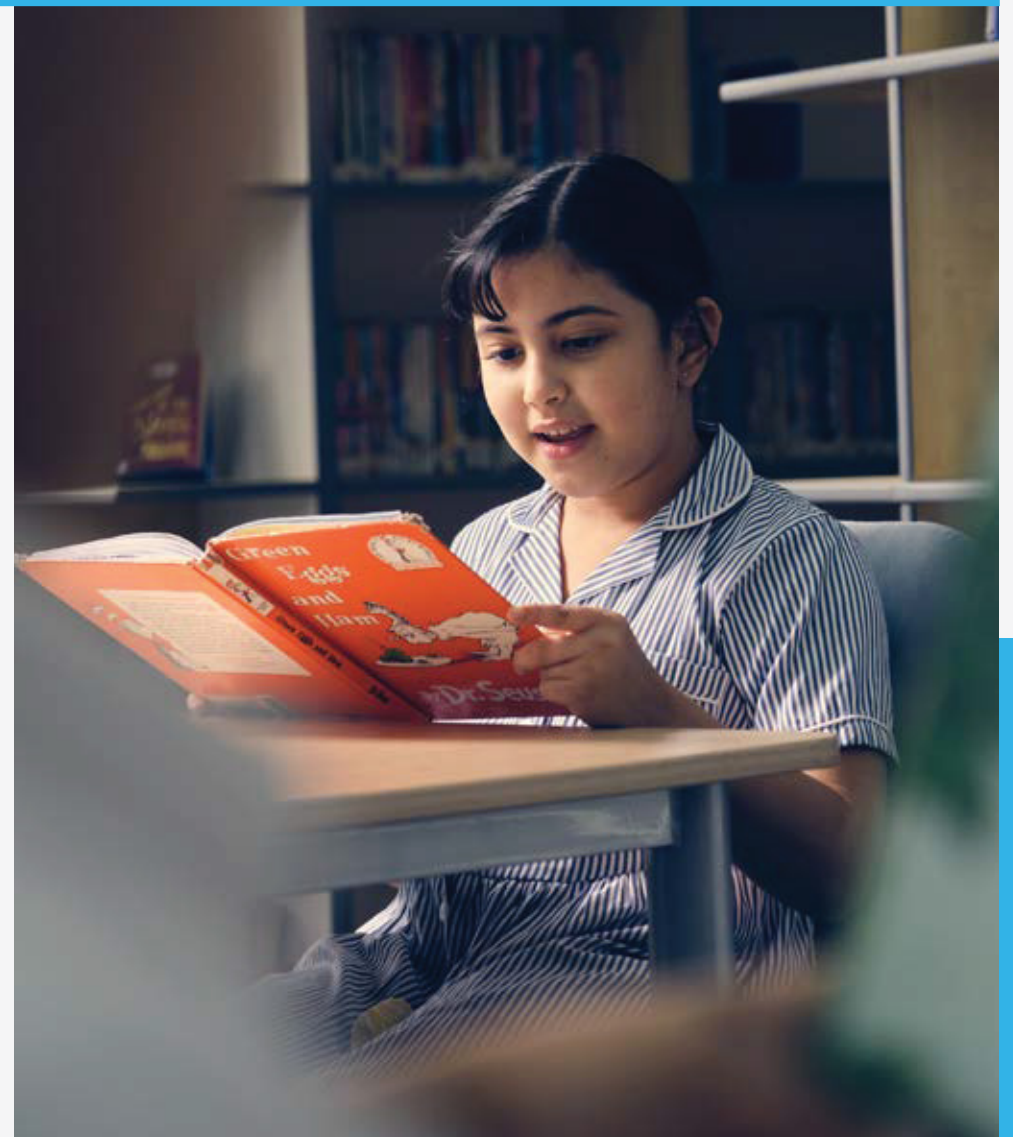

Our School Community

Our community of teachers, parents, pupils and support staff includes people from a very wide range of backgrounds and nationalities. A sense of mutual respect and warmth is important within the School and is actively nurtured through the School's values. Curriculum

We follow the National Curriculum for England and Wales, adapted for an international setting. We offer a mixture of GCSE and IGCSE subjects in Key Stage 4 and a range of A Levels and BTECs in Key Stage 5.

Current Strategic Developments within the Senior School

We have a fully embedded bring your own device policy in Seniors, including staff devices. This flexibility enables pupils and staff to work in ways that best suit them. In order to support staff in working with pupils in this way, we offer a range of CPD sessions to our staff around e-learning, using the Google Suite and apps for Education.

We have recently launched "Beyond BSB", an enrichment programme aimed at our upper school students to develop enthusiasm, knowledge and curiosity beyond the confines of a syllabus or curriculum. Students in Year 12 complete an independent research project, and we offer a weekly lecture series to develop a love of learning. All staff are expected to contribute one 30-minute lecture per academic year, pitched at Year 1 degree level. The programme is supplemented by a range of guest speakers from industry and academic institutions.

Why did you choose the British School of Bahrain?

After teaching in Muscat, I was looking for a different challenge. I heard great reviews of BSB from people who were working at some of the British schools in Muscat who either taught here themselves or who have family and friends teaching at BSB. The reviews were very positive, but the thing that struck me the most about the opinions of the people was that they all felt that BSB is an inclusive school not just for students but the community as a whole.

What do you like most about the British School of Bahrain?

The school as a whole cares about the community. No decisions are being made without analysing what the impact on the community will be.

What was the best surprise about the British School of Bahrain and Bahrain as a country?

BSB is a well-structured school with a high quality of professional teachers who really do care for the students. The students are extremely polite and it makes it so much easier to teach them.

Bahrain surprised me with how open they are to all cultures and people from all backgrounds. The country as a whole has a family orientated mentality, and one can feel it on a daily basis. The way the government has dealt with COVID-19, has proven that they do care for each individual and family alike, regardless of your nationality.

What are the students at BSB like?

The students are fantastic to work with. They are polite and very hard working. Classroom disruptions are very low. Teachers do get the opportunity to focus on the holistic development of the students. The students are really eager to learn and that also allows for more extension work and doing things that exceed just the classroom teaching.

What are your BSB colleagues like to work with?

The maths department is an absolute treat to work in. The staff are very supportive, and teamwork is our highest priority. Staff do not just care for the wellbeing of the students but more so care for the wellbeing of the members within the department. All members are extremely professional and take a lot of pride in their work. We have an attitude of "Students' teaching and learning first". And the staff really does apply it successfully.

BSB STUDENT PROFILE



How long have you been at BSB for?

I came to BSB just over one year ago. I came straight from the UK and settled very quickly into my class, and made new friends.

What do you love most about the British School of Bahrain?

I love that there is a sense of fun and that everyone is encouraged to be their own person. This allowed me to make new friends and gave me the confidence to try new things.

What do you think about the lessons?

I love my lessons and enjoy all of the topics that we have done. My favourite subject is Science although I enjoy PE, Drama and Music as well. We have weekly Cycle Tests, with each week focusing on a different subject. I was worried about these at first, but have realised they aren't too bad, and I like knowing what I have learnt and where I still need to focus on.

What are the other BSB teachers like?

The teachers are all very friendly and nice. They always try and make the lessons fun and interesting, which I like. The things we learn are often challenging, but the teachers are always there to explain and help each of us, which I enjoy. I also like that at the end of the topic, we get to give feedback to help design how the subject is taught in the future.

LIVING IN BAHRAIN

The Kingdom of Bahrain holds a unique place thanks to its geographic location in the Arabian Gulf and to its deep-rooted history. Both elements have created one of the most liberal cultures within the Middle East. It also enjoys an excellent regional and international reputation with regard to its efforts that aim to establish regional peace thanks to the initiatives of His Majesty King Hamad bin Isa Al Khalifa. The Kingdom of Bahrain has many different attractions to cater to a myriad of

interests. There is the rich heritage of ancient civilisations, with many temples, while Forts at Riffa, Arad and Bahrain Fort are remarkable examples of ancient architecture. Recently restored houses of Muharraq depict Bahraini style during the last century. The island has a history of pearl diving which is still a popular experience for visitors. Nature lovers visit the Al Areen wildlife sanctuary, where they will see flamingos, ostriches, camels and Oryx. The Tree of Life, which has survived for hundreds of years in the desert, is a popular attraction.

Bahrain has become a hub of sports in the Middle East, including, golf, horse

racing at Sakhir and of course the annual F1 Bahrain Grand Prix in March. As you would imagine, water sports are common, and diving is a popular pastime with a recently opened Diving Theme park featuring a Boeing 747 as well as many natural and artificial reefs.

Bahrain topped InterNations' 2018 list of the **best expat countries**. It is certainly one of the most friendly and welcoming of all the countries within the Middle East. Among the highlights noted were how well ex-pats are able to communicate, the country's overall friendliness, how easily ex-pats are able to make friends and settle in. Working hours, job security, and overall job

satisfaction also received high rankings internationally. Bahrain is considered the most liberal of all Gulf States and prides itself on its open and inclusive culture with a more relaxed atmosphere and society.

Life as an ex-pat tends to focus on a person or family's interests. Socialising is common within the numerous British social and sporting clubs; the Dilmun Club, Rugby Club, British Club, among many others.



WHY LIVE IN BAHRAIN

As far back as 3000BC, the Dilmun civilisation was a trade centre between the Indus Valley and Ancient Mesopotamia. The former capital of Qal'at al-Bahrain was declared a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 2005. Bahrain was taken over by the Assyrians, the Persian Empire and various Arab and Mediterranean countries. Since 1783, the Al Khalifa family have ruled Bahrain, and in the 1830s, Bahrain became a British Protectorate. In 1968 Britain ended its treaties in the Gulf, and in 1971 Bahrain became an independent country.

The climate of Bahrain is typical of the Middle East, with mild winters (average 10°C - 22°C) and hot summers (average 41°C). Rainfall is light and mostly confined to the more temperate winter months.

The winters in Bahrain feel like a European springtime, with crisp, cool but sunny days.

Housing and accommodation

All teaching staff will be accommodated in luxury service apartments for two weeks on arrival in lieu of a housing allowance.

Bahrain has many different areas to live in. The school, therefore, provides a housing allowance for expat staff, permitting them to choose what will best suit their needs and tastes.
