## **MONZA**

Monza is Lombardy's "second city", known for its Romanesque-Gothic cathedrals and its motor racing circuit within its walled park, home to the Italian Grand Prix.

Monza is a small city with an array of green spaces and a rich cultural heritage dating back to Roman times. Amongst its 120,000 inhabitants, many chose it for the benefits of its international outlook, affordable accommodation and quick rail access to the fashionable and buzzing city of Milan, as well as the world-renowned Italian lakes and mountains.

It is well-connected to the rest of the country by transportation networks, including highways and railways. The geographical proximity to Milan ensures easy access to the international airport and other key transportation hubs.

An important attraction within Monza is The Royal Villa - a historic palace located within Monza Park. It was built in the 18th century, serving as a residence for Austrian archdukes and later for the Italian royal family. Today, the villa is open to the public and hosts various cultural events.

#### Safeguarding


