KEY OBJECTIVES OF THE POSITION

Consistent with Nexus International School Malaysia policies, the Maths Lead Teacher will be responsible for overseeing and working with staff on:

- Establishing goals and expectations: includes the setting, communication and monitoring of learning goals, standards and expectations, and the involvement of staff and others in the process so that there is clarity and consensus about goals.
- Strategic resourcing: involves aligning resource selection and allocation to priority teaching goals.
- Planning, coordinating and evaluating teaching and the curriculum: direct involvement in the support
 and evaluation of teaching through regular classroom visits and feedback to teachers. Direct oversight
 of curriculum in the learning area through school wide coordination across classes and year levels and
 alignment to school goals.

• Promoting and participating in teacher learning and development: leadership that not only promotes but directly participates with teachers in formal or informal professional learning.

ROLE

Establishing goals and expectations

Key tasks

- Report to the Primary Leadership Team and assist in its work of leading and supporting the effective management of the school
- Oversee the written guidelines and procedures for Maths.
- Communicate school and curriculum goals and targets to relevant staff and parents in relation to maths

Strategic resourcing

Key tasks

- Advise PLT on needs of Primary school when budgeting and ordering new resources
- Align resources to maths goals and targets

Planning, coordinating and evaluating teaching and the curriculum

Key tasks

- Use a range of data in collaboration with the PLT to support the effective planning teaching and learning of Maths across the Primary school. (Support through co planning, modelling teaching)
- Contribute to school wide maths development, liaise with HOP, PLT, teachers and Head of Maths Secondary to ensure progression and continuity throughout the school
- Oversee the Maths curriculum as the leader of the Maths working party.
- Establish and maintain curriculum and procedures for review processes
- Ensure that all staff and students are working towards the goals and targets in all curriculum areas
- Define areas of the curriculum that need developing by individuals, year groups or as a primary school – based on data reviews

Promoting and participating in teacher learning and development

Key tasks

- Promote and model teacher professional learning in content and pedagogy
- Identify professional learning needs and plan for them to be part of the school development plan and meeting schedules

Ensuring an orderly and supportive environment

Key tasks

- Develop and maintain a collegial and supportive culture in maths that encourages risk taking and openness
- Ensure that communications with PLT, teachers, learners and parents are positive and effective, and consistent with school wide expectations
- Ensure that all staff are familiar with school wide systems and processes as applicable to maths
- In collaboration with PLT ensure assessment procedures and schedules are adhered to and data is reviewed.
