



ENGLISH FACULTY

At present, the department consists of six full-time teachers, all of which are English specialists. Our school SENCO is also a teaching member of the department.

At Key Stage 3, we follow an agreed schedule of work. All schemes of work are new to fit the current English curriculum and as a result are under constant review. KS3 groups are taught in mixed ability sets. Our aim is to work to ensure that students are in classroom environments that allow them to maximise their potential.

Currently all Key Stage 4 students are entered for AQA GCSE English Language and Literature. Years 9, 10 and 11 are grouped according to ability and GCSE FFTD targets.

The faculty also deliver Media Studies at KS4 in Year 10 and are currently developing SOLs for this new specification.

In the last three years the department have achieved the best results ever recorded at Baysgarth. The challenge is to continue delivering outstanding outcomes with examination only assessments.
