## MFL FACULTY

The Quest Academy – Coloma Trust has a MFL faculty consisting of 2 full-time specialist members of staff. All staff are keen to share good practice and are supportive of one another. All full-time teachers are expected to teach across the age and ability range including KS4 French and Spanish.

Most of MFL is taught in one area of two dedicated language rooms, all in the near vicinity of the MFL office. Each room has display boards for pupils' work.

### MFL KS3

Students follow a condensed Key Stage 3 course, in either French or Spanish, over two years and each student will follow a differentiated scheme of work in line with the National Curriculum. All year 7 and 8 students have two lessons of either French or Spanish per week.

### MFL KS4

Students follow AQA board courses for both French and Spanish and there is an opportunity to start Spanish GCSE in year 9. French and Spanish are offered as option subjects at GCSE level but all students completing the GCSE receive sit the Full Course examination. The progress of each student is monitored closely by the department and there are regular progress tests and internal examinations. GCSE French results in 2016 were exceptional with 92.3% of students obtaining A\*-C grades.

### MFL KS5

The Academy has just begun to offer A Level French. As the number of students studying languages at GCSE increases we hope to offer Spanish A Level as well. Students are currently following the Edexcel two-year French course, with an opportunity to sit the AS at the end of the first year, taught in 5 periods per week.
