International School Brunei (ISB) was established in 1964 as a not for profit organisation with a Board of Directors to oversee the development of the school; a status that exists to this day.

In 2015 the school moved to a brand new 22 acre site on the outskirts of Bandar Seri Begawan, the capital of Brunei Darussalam. At the same time, 'The Residence' a state of the art boarding house, was opened to cater for up to 120 students aged 11-18.

ISB offers education from Pre Kindy (2yrs) and an adapted British curriculum from Reception, followed by IGCSE and International Baccalaureate (IB) Diploma Programme.


ISB is an inclusive school and currently has over 1,100 students from more than 40 different nationalities. Academic results are outstanding and IB Diploma results are consistently above the world average.

In addition to the Bandar campus, ISB Seria caters for Primary and Middle Years students and our Centre for Inclusive Learning supports students with additional needs. ISB also offers CACHE adult learning across all campuses.
