Attainment and achievement

Our GCSE results in the summer 2019 were again outstanding. In all of our academic GCSE subjects our students out-performed their peers of similar ability significantly. The mathematics and English departments achieved almost half a grade better on average for every child of similar ability. Our traditional academic EBacc subjects (Chemistry, Physics, Biology, History, Geography, MFL and Computing) achieved fantastic outcomes. Our upper and lower ability students performed particularly well and in mathematics and the academic EBacc subjects they achieved in the top 15% of the country when compared to students of similar ability. These outcomes are set to continue in 2020 and 2021 across all of our subjects.
