- 3. To prepare and plan lessons, making use of non-directed time.
- 4. That you liaise, advise and monitor, any other teachers who work within your designated subject area.
- 5. That you monitor and evaluate your subject in order to:
- ♦ inform further subject action planning.
- ♦ use subject action planning information to inform the school development plan.
- ♦ to raise pupils standards of achievement.
- ♦ to achieve and maintain high standards of teaching and learning.

MANAGEMENT

- 1. That you ensure the effective continuity and progress of pupils work between Key Stages and year groups.
- 2. To use external comparative "Benchmark" information, and other supporting data, in order to set appropriate "Targets" within your subject by year group.
