Main Duties

- To provide a clean and pleasant environment for the teaching of pupils
- To help maintain the fabric of school building
- To maintain cleanliness in order to prevent any health risk from occurring in school

Job Description

Duties and responsibilities include cleaning a specified area of the school to a high standard as instructed and detailed in the guidance for cleaners including, but not limited to, the following:

- Wash floors, surfaces, fixtures and fittings and walls up to a specified height
 - Cleaning inside windows up to a specified height
 - Sweeping, washing and vacuuming floors
 - Polishing and dusting surfaces and furniture
 - Wipe and polish all tables
 - Replace chairs under tables.
 - Cleaning toilets, seats and pedestals, basins and shower areas with a disinfectant cleaner.
 - Use cleaning materials as appropriate, and according to their instructions for use
 - To empty bins and remove rubbish from the premises
 - To use power cleaning equipment as directed
 - Close windows and turn off lights
 - To undertake relevant Non Routine cleaning as instructed by the Supervisor
 - To undertake any relevant training as required
 - To comply with the requirements of the health and safety at work regulations

- To co-operate with the employer in ensuring that health and safety responsibilities are carried out
- Individuals have a responsibility for promoting and safeguarding the welfare of children and young people he/she is responsible for or comes into contact with.
- The deep cleaning of areas specified in the cleaning guidance document during school holidays
- To adhere to the ethos of the school
- Any other duties as commensurate within the grade in order to ensure the smooth running of the school
