Staffing

The Science Department consists of twelve full time teachers and two technicians. The department work together to deliver an engaging and challenging curriculum and contribute to the overall community atmosphere of which the school is proud.

Accommodation

There are 7 well-resourced laboratories and 3 classrooms, all situated together in the main block of the school. There are 2 well served by preparation rooms adjacent to the laboratories and 1 laboratory situated in the 6th Form.
