The successful candidate will be expected to:

- Plan and deliver imaginative, well-structured lessons across all age and ability ranges, in line with the vision of the English Department and the wider school.
- Use data to monitor, support, and record student progress, identifying those who need extension or additional support.
- Communicate effectively with parents, including at Parent-Teacher Interviews and through regular updates.
- Attend Parent Teacher Interviews for the classes you teach.
- Contribute to departmental planning, the development of schemes of work, and the preparation of shared resources.
- Work collaboratively with colleagues and attend departmental meetings.
- Support students outside of lessons through clubs and societies, revision sessions, and encouragement to participate in external competitions.
- Integrate ICT effectively into teaching and promote independent learning.
- Engage in CPD and INSET opportunities and regularly review teaching performance independently and with the Head of Department.
- Assist in reviewing syllabi proposed by Awarding Bodies and ensure curriculum matches the syllabi.
- Help evaluate exam outcomes and assist in curriculum planning to ensure alignment with exam board specifications.
- Contribute to wider school life, including organising and participating in extra-curricular activities, including trips for all key stages, both in the UK and abroad.
- Undertake any additional comparable duties as required by the Headmaster.
