We are seeking a Sports Graduate to work predominantly in our Senior School with some opportunities for teaching and coaching in the Junior School.

We are seeking to appoint a candidate with the ability to teach at least one or more of our sports to a high level: football, netball, hockey, cricket, or strength and conditioning. Or has appropriate qualifications and experience in other sports that we offer: dance, basketball, swimming and trampolining.

The successful candidate will be committed to supporting teams and individuals to succeed at all levels. The ideal candidate would have participated in their sport through school, clubs, or university, either through playing to 1st team level or gaining some coaching experience in these environments.

We expect candidates to be able to demonstrate clear potential to operate effectively in teaching and coaching sport to our children from 3-18, delivering pastoral care and making a positive contribution to other areas of school life. Those on a 'sandwich' year during a university course will be considered.

You will be primarily working in the Senior School and there will be opportunities to support the Junior School as a through-school model.

You will be a motivated and values-driven practitioner who promotes a competitive spirit within the teams they work with – one that balances high standards with mutual respect and support, regardless of individual abilities or outcomes.

Sport and physical education are integral to Royal Russell School. You will be part of a large department of 35 staff, led by our dynamic Director of Sport, Health, and Fitness.

You will be joining a team of sector-leading teachers and coaches, including ex-professional athletes and highly experienced teaching practitioners. You will share our passion for providing opportunities to develop a lifelong love of physical activity.

For the right candidate, there will also be the opportunity to gain experience of some classroom teaching of academic P.E, under the guidance of the main experienced teacher.

Candidates who are successful in their first year with us may have the opportunity to be supported through an on-the-job PGCE in their second year.

We believe the strength of a team starts with the people in the room. If you're driven, collaborative, and ready to grow something meaningful, we want to hear from you.



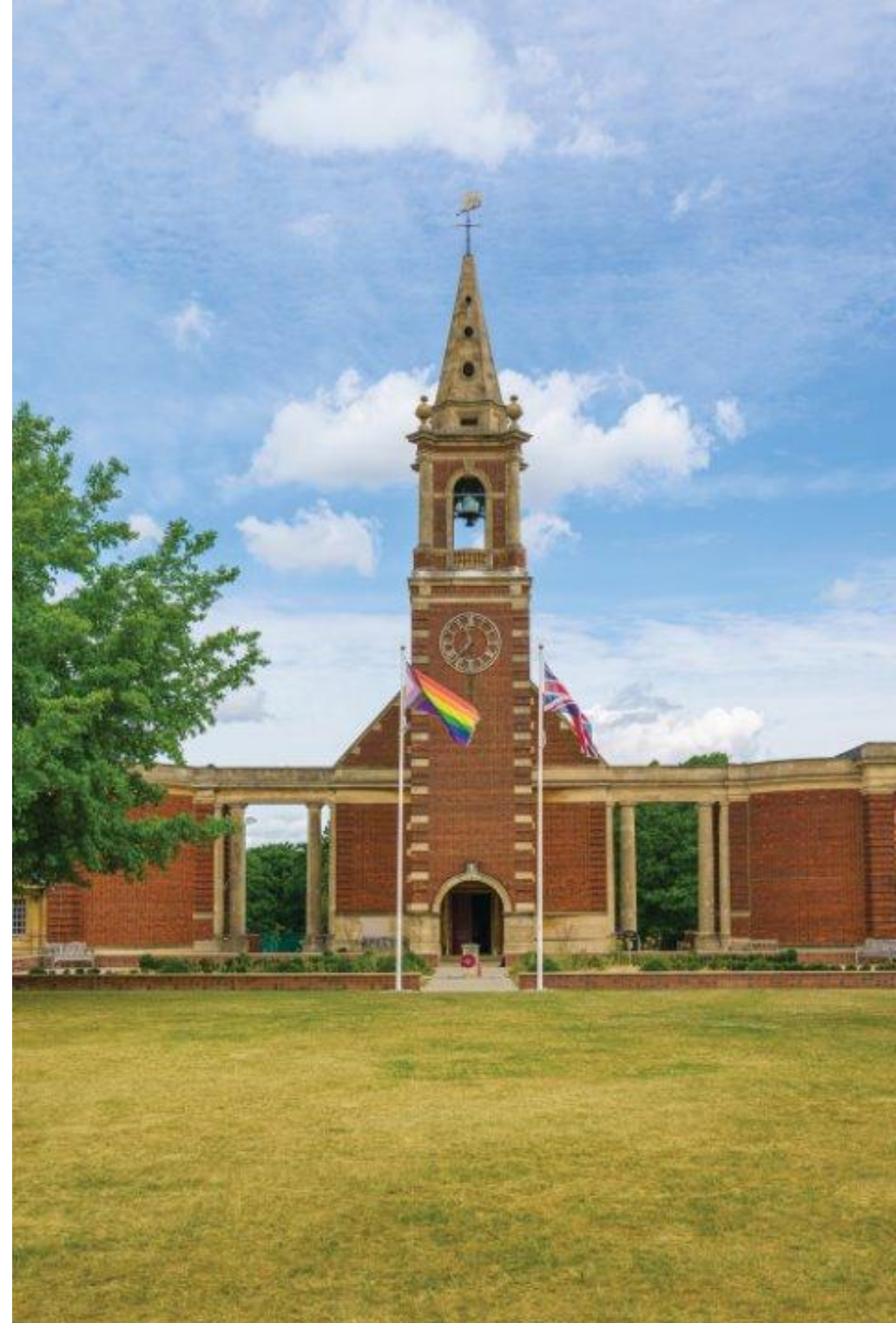
Key Responsibilities

Reports to: Director of Sport, Health and Fitness, and ultimately Headmaster

Job purpose: To positively contribute to the whole-school sports programme. Be actively involved in the extra-curricular life of the school offering a range of activities to enhance the pupil's learning outside of lessons.

Main duties and responsibilities:

- Deliver high quality and innovative sessions across all school age groups including extra-curricular activities
- Take a proactive and leading role in the whole school sports programme
- To take responsibility for sports teams including selection, leadership and officiating in our wide range of sports on offer
- The ability or potential ability to complete sports analysis would be an advantage but by no means essential
- To take responsibility for weekly communication with parents regarding team sheets
- Undertake weekend fixtures, including accompanying trips and activities, and sports tours
- Comply with all school policies
- Create a positive culture of pupil welfare and behaviour including taking an active role in pastoral matters
- Model high standards of dress, attendance and punctuality when on the school premises and in authorised school activities off site

General Responsibilities:

- Ensure the safety and well-being of children and young people at the School by adhering to and complying with the School's Safeguarding and Child Protection Policy and Procedure at all times
- Display correct staff identification at all times whilst on site
- Attend training and staff INSET sessions organised by the School to provide a consistent approach across the entire School staff population
- Adhere, at all times, to Health & Safety legislation, and all departmental policies and procedures, to ensure the safety of you and colleagues as well as pupils, staff and visitors.
- Attend Sport Scholarship Day, Royal Russell Day and Open Day in addition to the Saturday Sports programme
- Carry out any other reasonable duties as requested by the Headmaster or members of the Senior Management Team

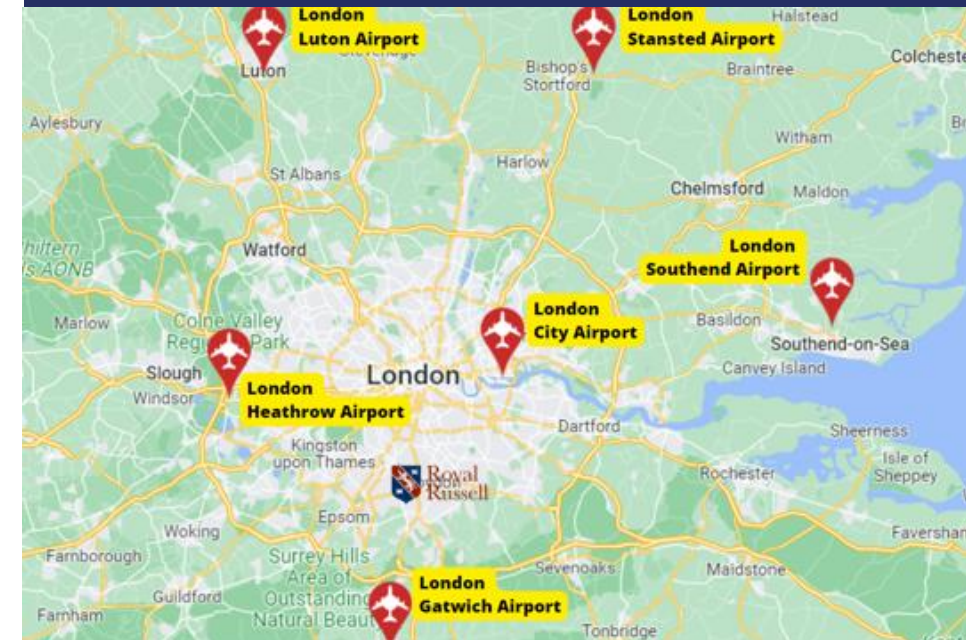
