- feedback to learners on how to progress
- make every effort to ensure that learners enjoy learning in the subject and understand its relevance in the wider world and to other learning
- undertake excellent monitoring of learner performance across Primary
- work with Primary teachers to develop learner self-confidence
- champion subject specific super-curricular and co-curricular clubs, events, and visits
- take responsibility for their own classroom behaviour management
- treats learners with respect and kindness in line with our school's ethos
- maintain excellent Communication with colleagues, SMT and parents
- ensure that learners have clear guidance on how to improve their work and engage in a dialogue with staff about this.

- Plan and carry out a regular programme of assessment tasks and attend moderation meetings as appropriate.
- Provide assessment data and information to the Senior Teachers and Principal at appropriate points in the academic cycle.
- Work to ensure that an environment is created which will enable students to achieve the highest academic standards.
- Plan and evaluate schemes of work in all areas that they teach.
- Prepare written and oral reports on the progress of individual students for parents and the stakeholders.
- Produce appropriate weekly lesson plans that show how the schemes of work are being taught.
- Plan and prepare resources appropriate for the different needs of students who they teach.
- Report to Head of Primary on resource needs and developments within the subject.
- Work as part of a team to promote the subject through written and oral presentations to colleagues, parents, students and the wider community as appropriate.

- Work as part of a team to prepare a term-by-term summary of subject-specific curriculum provision focusing on the knowledge, skills and understanding to be developed.
- Make a positive contribution to effective team building.
- Ensure pastoral needs of students are met.
- Make a positive contribution to extra-curricular activities.
- These tasks will be developed into short and longer-term targets in consultation with the teacher concerned.
