PURPOSE

To lead our Primary and Early Years school libraries. To promote both reading for pleasure and information literacy skills directly and in close collaboration with our curriculum leads; to lead and support activities that contribute to the development of lifelong learners and informed digital citizens.

SPECIFIC RESPONSIBILITIES

Leadership

- Will oversee the management of budgeting, selection, acquisition, cataloguing and processing of the collection and of online subscriptions.
- Will oversee and support the professional and technical goals that the librarians set for themselves annually; focussing on library and resource development.
- Oversee the maintenance of the library management system to ensure that all resources are accounted for and easily accessible.
- Work collaboratively with the Secondary School Teacher Librarian

Strategic Development

- Engage with and work towards the whole school strategic focus areas for the year
- Align personal and team goals with strategic priorities through the professional learning cycle

Promotion of Love of Reading

- Will actively promote and support literacy throughout the school community, both by planning and delivering literacy based activities and by collaborating with other teachers, both curricular and super curricular.
- Will develop and maintain a broad collection of books and online resources, representing the diversity of the school community.
- Will expose students to a wide range of genres and text formats through resource selection and activities.
- Organise and manage special events, author visits, competitions, collaborations and activities

that promote literacy and the love of reading.

Teaching and Learning

- Will support students and staff in accessing, evaluating, and using information from a variety of sources.
- In liaison with specialist teachers, will encourage the use of the library across all subject areas; especially Learning Support, English as an Additional Language and World Languages.
- Will liaise with the wider professional teacher librarian community, both in Kuala Lumpur and in S. E. Asia to share good practice.
- Will collaborate with curriculum leads in the establishment and implementation of suitable academic integrity strategies and expectations.
