- GCSE or Level 2 equivalent qualifications in English & Maths.

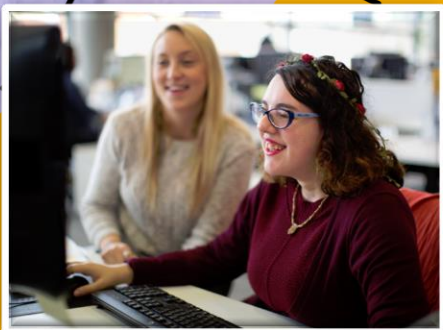
