## **Objectives:**

- To be responsible for the learning and achievement of all students in the class/es ensuring equality of opportunity for all;

## Specific responsibilities to the role:

The Second in Mathematics Faculty shall:

- Liaise with teachers in order to identify under achieving students and develop strategies to overcome this;

- Work alongside the Head of Mathematics and Assistant Headteacher to deliver numeracy across the curriculum;
- Act as a subject mentor for associate teachers and newly qualified teachers.
- To line manage subject staff with regard to specific subject schemes of work, assessment and promoting outstanding teaching and learning.
- To line manage and performance manage a number of staff in relation to set performance management guidelines as directed by the Head of Mathematics.
