

Food Department

The Food department at Formby High School is part of an outstanding Technology faculty which consists of Business Studies, Computing, Design Technology, Engineering, Food, Hospitality and Catering and ICT.

The Design Thinking department incorporates Design Technology, Engineering and Food (KS3) and Hospitality and Catering (KS4).

We have one fully equipped Design Technology workshop. Design Technology is taught at Key Stage 3. Engineering is taught as a BTEC at Key Stage 4 and 5.

We have one fully equipped kitchen that is used solely for teaching of Food at Key Stage 3 and Hospitality and Catering at Key Stage 4. Both practical and theory lessons take place in this room. It is a very popular choice amongst students at Formby High School. This is a high achieving department that consists of one full time member of staff and a part-time technician.

At Key Stage 4 students currently follow the Eduqas Hospitality and Catering level 1/2 Award. This includes the examination at the end of year 10. In year 11 students are to complete the none examined assessment (NEA) part of the course which includes a practical element.

The department help to deliver Enrichment lessons at Key Stage 5 and often offers a variety of extra-curricular activities. This is a thriving, hard-working, innovative and dedicated department.
