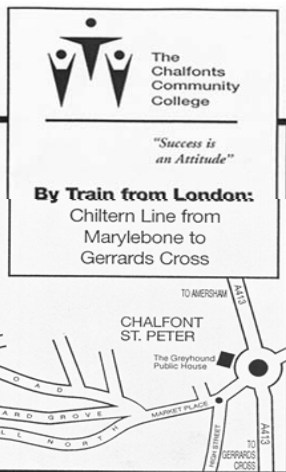
About the school



The Chalfonts is the one of the largest secondary schools in South Buckinghamshire (1650 students, 200 in the Sixth Form) yet doesn't 'feel' like a massive school. About the location of the school



Chalfont St Peter is a village and civil parish in Chiltern district in south-east Buckinghamshire, England. It is in a group of villages called The Chalfonts which also includes Chalfont St Giles and Little Chalfont. The villages lie between High Wycombe and Rickmansworth.

Chalfont St Peter is one of the largest villages in the UK with nearly 13,000 residents. Chalfont St Peter is in close proximity to central London (15 miles (24 km) (20 minutes by train), Heathrow Airport, Pinewood and Elstree film studios, and the motorway network (M25, M40, M1 and M4).

About attractions in the area

The Chalfonts Community College has an on-site leisure centre with reduced rates for staff and local amenities across Chalfont St Peter and Gerrards Cross include many bars, coffee shops, restaurants and shopping facilities.

Buckinghamshire has a fabulous choice of attractions from unearthing 2000 years of its history, to brand new high wire adventure parks at Go Ape in Wendover and Black Park. Why not visit Aylesbury Waterside Theatre to see performances of West End and touring musicals and plays, along with ballets and operas and even a Christmas Pantomime.

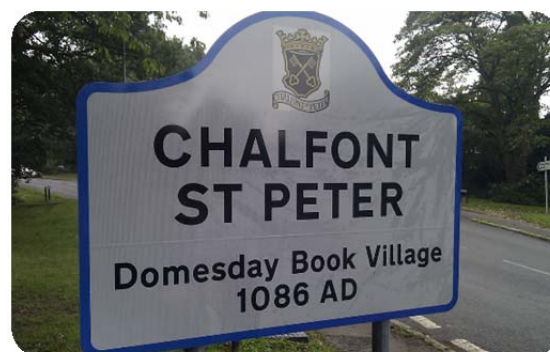
How about jumping on a steam train at The Chinnor and Princes Risborough Railway or stepping back in time at The Chiltern Open Air Museum.
