## Race Leys Junior School Location

Race Leys Junior School is situated in Bedworth in the West Midlands in the county of Warwickshire.

The Bull Ring Shopping Centre, Cinema and Entertainment complex is a 20 minute drive away. There is also a local shopping complex at in Nuneaton and a wide range of shops and amenities available at the nearby Ricoh Arena.
